APPLY FOR COLLEGE

Choose schools and apply for admission (Application fee waivers might be available)

Dates on Campus Websites

To be eligible for a Cal Grant, the California Student Aid Commission must receive your school-verified GPA. Call **1-888-CA-GRANT (1-888-224-7268)** with questions. The state financial aid priority deadline is **March 2**.

If you're planning to attend a California Community College, **September 2 is your last chance to apply for a Cal Grant.*
