SUBJECT: 2017-18 Cal Grant Transfer Entitlement Awards

This Operations Memo from the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) provides an update on the 2017-18 California Community College (CCC) Transfer Entitlement Awards.

- The Commission identified and sent notifications to 28,923 applicants with potential eligibility for the CCC Transfer Entitlement Award.
 - Potentially eligible applicants for the 2017-18 Transfer Entitlement Award will be processed on a weekly basis throughout the academic year.
- Notified applicants must complete the Cal Grant Transfer Entitlement (G-6) self-certification form by logging into their WebGrants for Students account at www.webgrants4students.org
 - The Commission will process the G-6 self-certification forms on a weekly basis.
- Students offered a Cal Grant Transfer Entitlement Award will appear on campus rosters beginning in May 2017

Community College Enrollment Files

- The Commission uses community college enrollment files to identify potentially eligible Cal Grant Transfer Entitlement students.
- Participating community colleges that have not uploaded their 2016-17 winter and spring student enrollment data should submit as soon as possible.
