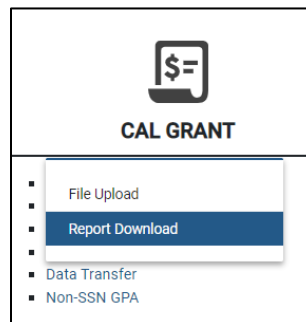
SUBJECT: **New Financial Aid Application Status Report**

This Special Alert from the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) is pleased to announce the availability of a new Financial Aid Application Status Report aimed to support schools and school districts with the new requirement per [California Education Code Section 51225.7](#). Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) are required to confirm that high school seniors complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or California Dream Act Application (CADAA). Students may alternatively complete an opt-out form, which shall be collected and retained by the high school.

A **NEW** report has been developed to assist schools with tracking their students through the financial aid application process, including GPA submission, financial aid completion and Cal Grant awarding. The “**Financial Aid Application Status Report**” is available in WebGrants and offered in txt and csv formats for ease of use.

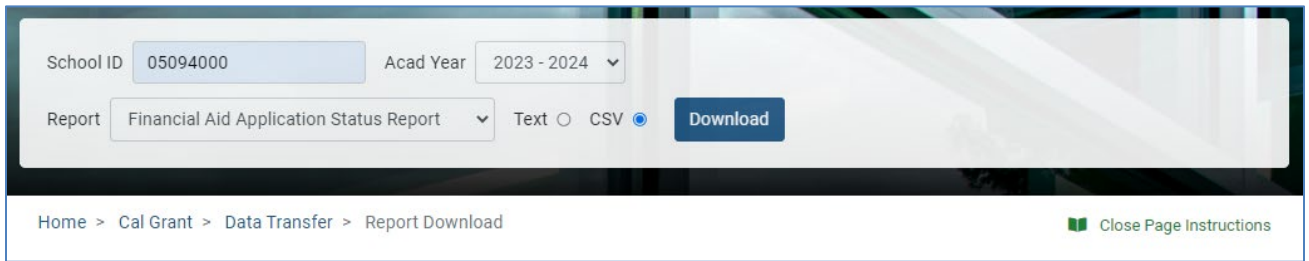
How to Access the Report

- Log in to WebGrants
- Click “Data Transfer” under the Cal Grant section on the homepage
 - Click “Report Download” on the pop-up menu



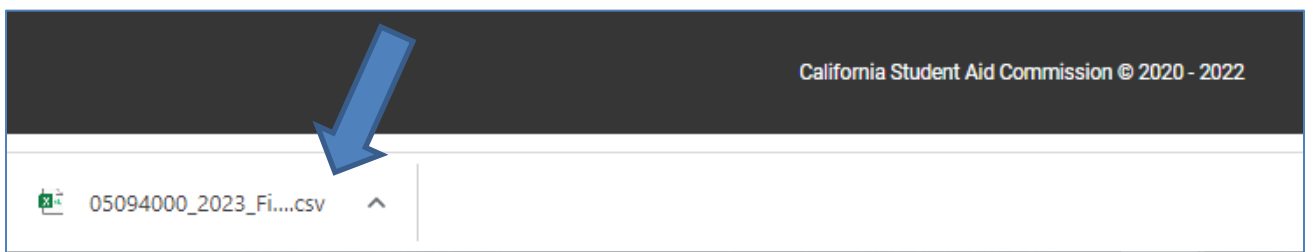
- Click the down arrow for “Report” and select “Financial Aid Application Status Report”

- Choose Text or CSV

Highlights of the Report

- CSV Format option: Easy to sort and filter.
- Data on the report is extracted in real time, allowing users to have up-to-date information on-demand.
- The “Action needed” column on the report, allows users to filter which students need to submit a financial aid application, resolve errors on their application, or need a GPA uploaded.
 - This filter option allows for targeted outreach and clear action steps to ensure every eligible student has completed a financial aid application.
- Data columns include SSID, GPA Uploaded, Application Submitted, EFC, GPA Matched, Awarded Cal Grant, and Action Needed.
