The Get Schooled Foundation is Giving Away 5 \$1,000 Scholarships in 2018

Sacramento (2018) - High school seniors across California are urged to complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or California Dream Act Application (CADAA) at local Cash for College workshop prior to the March 2, 2018 Cal Grant deadline. Any senior who attends a Cash for College Workshop and completes a six-question exit survey will become eligible for 1 of 5 \$1,000 scholarship awards; in addition to tens-of-thousands of dollars available in federal, state and campus-based financial aid.

“California has over \$2.2 billion in college and career training financial aid for families with income and assets up to \$165,000,” said Lupita Cortez Alcalá, executive director of the California Student Aid Commission, which administers state grant financial aid programs. “We strongly encourage high school seniors to apply. The Student Aid Commission works with its regional partners to provide free assistance for families to complete the online application.”

Too often, students and their parents believe there isn't enough money available to pay for a college education or career training. The Student Aid Commission can help graduating high school seniors – and students who have been out of high school for less than one year -- to determine their eligibility for Cal Grants, Middle Class Scholarships, the Chafee Grant for foster youth; and, other state grant aid programs.
