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## **IMPORT SPECIFICATIONS GUIDELINES**

#### FORMAT GUIDELINES

All *Collection Types* (Enrollment, Persistence, Graduation, Job Placement and Unitary) must be submitted in separate fixed field length files that shall not exceed 25MB.

All files must adhere to the file name specifications and the file name shall not exceed 32 characters including the file type extension.

#### CORRECTIONS TO UPLOADED DATA

If corrections are required to a submitted file, make the correction to the file, and resubmit the **entire** file. The previous version of the uploaded file will be overwritten by the latest version.

## CLASSIFICATION OF INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS (CIP) CODE

The CIP Code is required for reporting program completion data only. The Commission is using the 2010 version of the CIP Code, which can be found at: <a href="http://nces.ed.gov/ipeds/cipcode/browse.aspx?y=55">http://nces.ed.gov/ipeds/cipcode/browse.aspx?y=55</a>. For purposes of reporting SB 70 data use the 6-digit code without the decimal point.

#### **ENROLLMENT TYPE**

Enrollment type is the total number of students enrolling at the institution that are either "first-time" college students or "transfer" students. First time represents students who are enrolling in college for the *First Time* (e.g. no prior college credit), and *Transfer* represents students with prior college credit.

Students who have completed at least 24 semester or 36 quarter units for all terms attended during the academic year (July 1<sup>st</sup> through June 30<sup>th</sup>) should be reported as full-time. Students who have completed less than 24 semester or 36 quarter units for all terms attended during the academic year should be reported as part-time.

Data for summer terms that commence prior to July 1st should be included in the institution's SB70 data submission for the academic year ending June 30th. For example, if the summer term commences on June 15, 2015, that data would be included in SB70 data submission for the 2014-15 academic year.
