ECMC

Who is ECMC

- · Established in 1994 as:
 - Transition Federal Family Education Loan (FFEL)
 Program portfolios, as requested by the U.S.
 Department of Education, for guarantors that exit the Program

-1996 Virginia -2010 Connecticut

-2005 Oregon -2010 California

 A national federal student loan bankruptcy servicer—currently providing bankruptcy servicing for 22 guaranty agencies and U.S. Department of Education



Who is ECMC (cont.)

ECMC

- · National FFEL Program guaranty agency
- In 2001, ECMC Group was established as a nonprofit parent company
 - At the core is our not-for-profit activity supporting the administration of federal student loan programs—including outreach to underserved student populations to increase college access, retention and success
 - We are expanding beyond our nonprofit role and pursuing other avenues for growth



Portfolio transfer to ECMC



- Commitment of transparency to borrowers, schools and other industry partners
 - · Conversion of loans to ECMC
 - · 9-12 month process
 - · December 6, 2010 EdFund staff converted to ECMC employees
 - · Continue to work with current contacts
 - · Communications Borrowers
 - · Borrowers in school work with schools and lenders
 - Borrowers in delinquency notified of ECMC through course of normal correspondence
 - Borrowers in default received notification of loan transfer to ECMC
 - · Communications Industry Partners
 - Update throughout conversion
 - Notification of any changes to processes, contact information
 - Notification of training and product enhancements

Direct Assistance

- ECMC will help provide CSAC:
 - IT Help Desk tier one support for student and institution calls
 - Mail/print/copy support for Cal Grant eligibility and status letters
 - · Interactive Voice Response System
 - · Answers 75,000 calls annually



Direct Assistance

- Document imaging system
 - Quick and easy access to forms
 - Increase system data accuracy and allow for compliance with state laws.



Cash For College



- Continue to provide CFC materials for over 600 workshops
- Provide funds for CFC scholarships previously provided by College Access Foundation



Training & Outreach

- High School Counselors and College Financial Aid Administrators
 - Short video clips to provide student assistance
 - Cal Grant training videos for institutions
 - Restoration of support for CASFAA High School Counselors Workshops
 - Design, production and shipping of materials
 - · Cal Grant trainers at all workshops
